#### 3. Minutes of the Previous Meeting

The minutes of the previous annual general meeting on 22<sup>nd</sup> April 2021 were agreed and signed.

#### 4. Conversations on the work of God - Annual Report for 2021/2022

Annual report- Ian commented that again there was no guide report in the document and that all units of the uniformed organisations were short of leaders although full to capacity with children. This year the Monday Brownie unit has also had to close. Sue was thanked, along with Eluned for preparing the report. It was explained that Eluned's role had taken the pressure off the stewards and church notices and services were prepared by her.

A question about wearing a mask during the service was raised when no one wore a mask while drinking coffee. Most people agreed that due to singing a mask was preferred.

It had been suggested that an experienced musician was required as pianists were few and some had to play more than they would like. Hiring an organist had been looked into pre covid but this proved not to be an option. This will mean that we need to adapt our singing to more recorded music. Chris did not want to play at services at the moment due to covid fears but it was suggested that he might prerecord hymns at his practise sessions that could be used during services.

**Financial Report.** – Richard thanked his team and highlighted that the budget had been set with a planned deficit of £10000. He was grateful for the loyal donors, many of whom, while transferring direct debits to the new bank account, had raised their giving amount so funds remained buoyant despite the financial climate and sad loss of members.

Accounts were accurate as David records monthly gas and electricity usage so bills are based on consumption. Margaret will be issuing Gift Aid certificates soon and Mike keeps an eye on balancing the accounts. All Saints will be facing inflation pressures when we need the heating next autumn.

An unexpected expense to the budget of between £4000-£5000 will be to replace the fire door in the hall as it is not working. An extra church council meeting or email agreement may need to be arranged to agree this expenditure.

Ian thanked the departing stewards for their extended time period of serving and for their leadership during the lockdowns of covid.

It was acknowledged that the even smaller steward group cannot function fully so will need the support of worship stewards. Trisha Evans was added to the list of worship stewards but more volunteers for this role are also required so that duties fall no more frequently than once a month. Jobs such as lighting the candle or getting the water ready could all help lighten the load. It was agreed that a job description be prepared so people could see the tasks to take on by it was mentioned that congregation is now mostly an older and frailer generation.

There would be no All Saints initiatives planned for the Queen's platinum jubilee but the CIA encouraged people to join in the planned events, especially at Rye Farm.

The meeting was asked to give Ian, Church Council and the stewards authority to appoint new stewards within the coming year.
